

Dear Parent,

It is of utmost importance that you be aware of the Haycock Camping Ministries discipline policy. Please review the following policy with your son/daughter prior to arrival at camp to ensure understanding of what is expected during the week. Please bring this signed form with you to camp when you register.

Haycock Camping Ministries is a non-denominational camp that strives to lead individuals to Christ and train them to serve Him. As such, the following conduct policy will be utilized in an endeavor to provide a fun, safe environment.

**General Rules of Conduct**

1. Show respect to others by using acceptable words, actions, and tone of voice. This includes respecting others' feelings, opinions, and property.
2. Use of crude language, curses, demonstrating or vocalizing disrespect towards other campers or staff will not be permitted.
3. Keep your hands, feet, and personal objects to yourself and do not interfere with others.

While Haycock staff will deal with each situation on a case by case and individual basis, the following are general consequences that staff may impose as forms of discipline.

**Consequences for General Misconduct**

- Camper may lose 1 round of archery or riflery
- Camper may lose 10 minutes of pool time
- Camper may be permitted to only purchase 1 or 2 snack items at the camp store (normally, campers may purchase three snack items a day).

After repeated offenses, the Executive Director will notify parents explaining the camper's misconduct. If the problems persist, the camper will be removed from their group until a parent can come to camp and pick their child up.

**Severe Offenses**

1. Fighting.
2. Significant damage to property.
3. Blatant disregard for authority and/or rules.
4. Leaving the camp premises unsupervised, habitual cursing, vulgar language, including explicit references to human anatomy.
5. Ethnic and racial remarks.

**Consequences for Severe Offenses**

Whenever a severe offense occurs, the parents will be immediately notified of the situation. If the problem continues, the camper will be removed from their group until a parent can come to camp and pick their child up.

**Sending a Camper Home**

We promise to first exhaust every possible method of reaching out to unruly campers. We will only send a camper home if his continued misbehavior is threatening other campers or if it causing a persistent disruption to camp activities.
